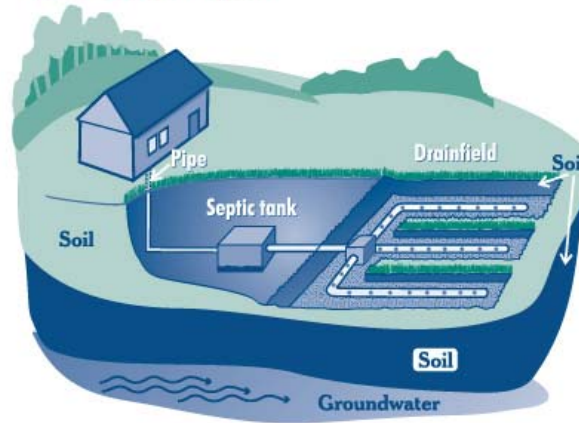

## Do's and Dont's to help extend the life of your septic

### DO

Have your tank pumped and maintained every 2-3 years by a licensed and insured professional

### DO

Keep your system location, pumping and maintenance records on this brochure.

### DO

Practice water conservation, fix the leaky faucet, broken toilet and only run the dishwasher when full.

### DO

Take left over chemicals to approved collection centers.

### DON'T

Flush any trash or non-biodegradable items; it **will harm your system.**

### DON'T

Allow anyone to park over your septic system unless it has been designed for it. The area should be left undisturbed and mowed to prevent root damage to pipe lines and system.

### DON'T

Allow anyone without a proper license and insurance to make repairs.

### DON'T

Allow anyone to work on the inside of the tank without proper equipment.

### DON'T

Flush harsh household chemicals and cooking oil down the drain.

## How Do You Know When Your System is Failing?

1. Toilets or drains are slow to drain.
2. System is backing up into tub or laundry.
3. There is ponding or saturated soil over the system.
